Cherokee Development Authority

- Motor in Well 7 went out. Motor was replaced, but when installing old motor noticed the shaft was stripped out. Shaft and motor have been repaired.
- Meter in Well 10 froze during February winter storm. Steps were taken to try and repair, but those repairs were only temporary, and meter is no longer operable. A new 6" water meter has been ordered.
- Fuse was blown at Lagoons, causing electricity to go out. Emergency generator worked properly, and AEC was called to make appropriate repairs.
