Master Sergeant (Retired) Peter D. Stein ended his career as the Director of Medical Education in the 19th Aerospace Medicine Squadron at Little Rock Air Force Base, Arkansas. He managed medical education for 355 providers and technicians as well as CPR and basic lifesaver courses for 6,500 base personnel. He was also the functional manager for Bioenvironmental Environmental Engineering for Little Rock Air Force Base. He oversaw 13 technicians performing activities in the fields of industrial hygiene, occupational health, radiological health, environmental protection, and medical emergency response. He ensured adequate guidance was provided to Squadron Commanders to make informed decisions in the maintenance of healthy working conditions for 6,500 Team Little Rock combat airlifters and to safeguard against any adverse effects caused.



Sergeant Stein graduated from Cherokee High School Oklahoma in 1996, played collegiate level basketball and entered the Air Force in March 2000. His background includes various duties in the Security Forces career field, joint contingency operations and various leadership rolls within his time as a medical asset. His assignments include bases in Oklahoma, England, Washington and Arkansas. Sergeant Stein's contingency experience has taken him from the United Arab Emirates working with the Emirate Army to Iraq embedded with US Army Special Operations Command capturing key Al Qaeda regime members, to serving the Deputy Chief of Staff of Strategies Plans and Assessments, Multi National Forces-Iraq as a personal security team member, to leading his own Law and Order team to Kandahar Air Field, Afghanistan. He supported mission operations such as Operation Southern Watch, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and Operation Enduring Freedom.
