THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS MAYOR TYLER MEAD THEN ASKED FOR ADJOURNMENT.

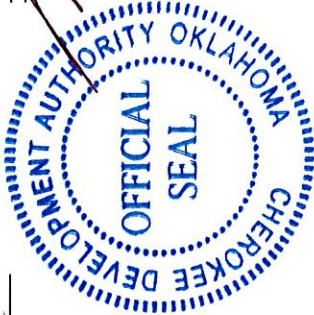

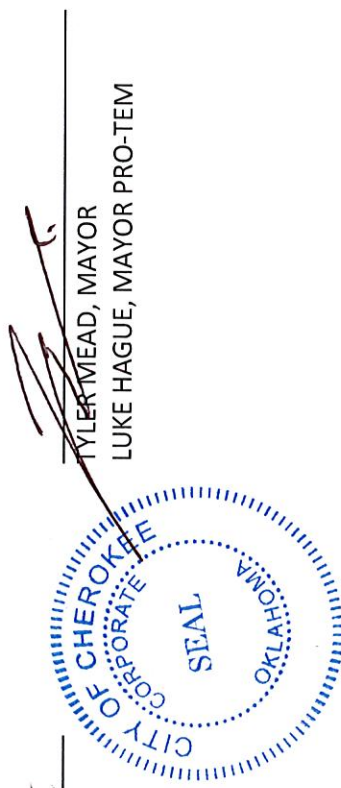
